Family Challenge

Share with your child how the skill of organization is used to keep the family on track. Do you have a family calendar of activities that is easily referred to by all? Is there a running grocery list where items are added to in between trips? Do your kids have specific jobs when they come home from school: unpack backpack, pack snack, chores? Everyone has a role in keeping the family organized.

Introduce checklists: What are those 3 things that you are constantly verbally reminding your child to do?
Consider making a visual checklist for them to refer to and check off. Put the checklist in a ziplock bag so it can be crossed off on the plastic when the task and done, then whipped clean for the next day. Depending on age, you may want to add visual cues/pictures of the task being completed.
