Required Enrollment Documents

Please have the following required documents in digital form before you start the online registration process.

Enrollments cannot be processed without the following 5 documents. For more information on required documents click on the tabs below.

1. Certified copy of your child's birth certificate. Must be in English.
2. Proof of home ownership or current lease
3. Current gas or electric bill showing the date, address and parent's name
4. Up-to-date immunization records in English
5. Current parent driver's license or passport

THE GIFT OF TIME!!

“Transitional kindergarten is a school grade that serves as a bridge between preschool and kindergarten, functioning to provide students with time to develop fundamental skills needed for success in school in an age- and developmentally-appropriate setting.” Transitional kindergarten recognizes the differences between a child’s chronological age and their developmental age (Moran, 2015).



KINDERGARTEN 101

SELF HELP SKILLS

- * Uses the bathroom independently
- * Zips coat
- * Take shoes on and off
- * Buttons/snaps pants
- * Recognizes his/her first name



FINE MOTOR SKILLS

- * Holds a pencil (not a fist grip)
- * Writes first name
- * Uses scissors to cut basic shapes *
- Trace lines and shapes
- * Colors or draws a picture

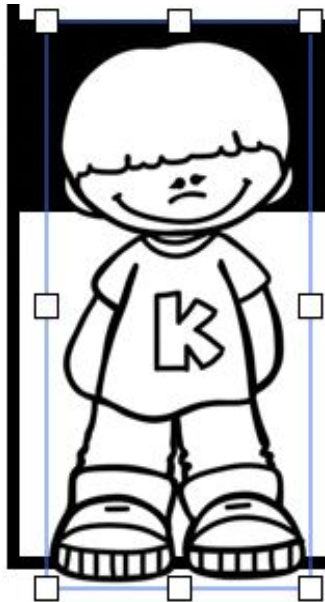


SOCIAL SKILLS

- * Completes 2-step directions
- * Sits and listens to someone read a story for 5-10 minutes
- * Plays a game and can accept losing
- * Completes short tasks without an adult's help.
- * Can control emotions without tantrums.
- * Takes turns while playing

ACADEMIC SKILLS

- * Count to 20 and recognize numbers 0-10
- * Sing and say ABC's
- * Identifies 10 or more letters & sounds
- * Follows directions from adults
