








Emile and the Field by Kevin Young


Emile loves the field close to his home in spring, summer, and fall, but not as much in winter, when he has to share his beautiful, changeable field with other children and their sleds.

by Leo Lionni


Two mice talk about where the seasons come from.

by Maxwell Eaton


Bear sets out to build a house from scratch before winter comes.
